

Cooperation agreement Scalda and Ørsted

The Zeeland educational institution Scalda and energy company Ørsted have signed a cooperation agreement. The institution for secondary vocational education (MBO) and adult education and the energy company will cooperate in the field of education for offshore wind energy. Ørsted is going to build the Borssele wind farm 1 + 2 off the coast of Zeeland.

Scalda and Ørsted have agreed that the energy company will give guest lectures, organise company visits and create internships. Ørsted is also advising Scalda in setting up the Center for Innovative Craftsmanship for Offshore Wind within the MBO.

Véronique van de Reijt, Director of Technology and Maritime at Scalda: "Responding to important regional developments in Zeeland, such as wind energy, is an important spearhead for Scalda. We always do this in close cooperation with the business community. The cooperation with Ørsted is a great example of this."

Jasper Vis, Country Manager of the Netherlands for Ørsted: "As the international market leader in offshore wind, we naturally want to contribute to creating good vocational education for the wind energy industry. And we naturally want to do that in Zeeland, because we need great professionals in Zeeland in the coming years, such as maintenance personnel for the Borssele wind farms."
